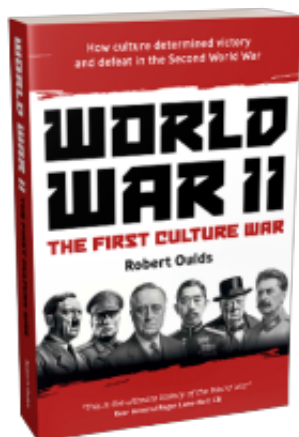


World War II: The First Culture War
